Keystone Adaptive Center – A Program of BOEC – to Host Team Semper Fi, Feb. 10-12

[Keystone, Colo., February 10, 2020] – The Keystone Adaptive Center – a program of the Breckenridge Outdoor Education Center (BOEC) – will provide approximately 60 ski and ride lessons to members and families of Team Semper Fi in a three-day event, February 10-12 at Keystone Resort, as part of the BOEC's [Heroic Military Program](#).

The Heroic Military Program is designed for men and women who serve our country and are now faced with the challenge of accepting and living with a disability. This program welcomes family members to participate as they are also deeply affected by the tragedy and are a critical part of the healing process.

“This is a great partnership between Team Semper Fi and the BOEC,” said Jeff Inouye, Director of the BOEC Adaptive Ski & Ride Program. “We cherish the opportunity to help them not only build relationships with fellow disabled military folks, but to help their families get out and enjoy themselves on the slopes.”

The staff and volunteers from the Keystone Adaptive Center and BOEC will come together to provide group and one-on-one lessons for beginner to advanced skiers and riders in a variety of adaptive disciplines, including two-track, four-track, ski-bike, snowboard, mono, and bi-ski lessons. This is also an important opportunity for Team Semper Fi members to connect with one another and share similar experiences on and off the slopes.

About the Keystone Adaptive Center (KAC)

The KAC – a program of the BOEC – opened in 2005 to serve people with disabilities and other special needs through outdoor recreation, including adaptive skiing, snowboarding and cycling. Through the generosity of Keystone Resort and the community, KAC conducted 703 lessons during the 2018-19 winter season. The mission of the KAC is to expand the potential of people with disabilities and special needs through meaningful, educational and inspiring outdoor experiences.
