The BOEC Climbing Camp is an all new camp in the summer of 2021 that is open to local teens (12-17 years old) of all abilities. Join us for a unique and challenging climbing camp experience where you will learn the basics to climbing, leadership skills, and so much more! We'll start things off using our climbing wall, located on our 39-acre campus overlooking Breckenridge, but also spend a day on our ropes course and a one-day field trip to a local rock climbing area. You must be independent with Activities of Daily Living (ADLS) or bring an attendant.
