



BOEC COVID-19 Participation Agreement

October 1, 2021

As of October 1st, 2021, BOEC will require all participants, staff and volunteers to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 in order to participate in any BOEC program. In addition, non-participating person's accompanying a BOEC participant(s) will be required to be fully vaccinated for COVID-19.

Covid-19 Vaccination Requirements:

- Must receive currently available COVID-19 vaccination and remain current with boosters per FDA guidelines.
- Fully Vaccinated Against Covid-19:
 - An individual is fully vaccinated against Covid-19 two weeks after they have received the second dose in a two-dose series of a Covid-19 vaccine (Pfizer BioNTech or Moderna) or two weeks after they have received a single-dose Covid-19 vaccine (Johnson & Johnson).
 - Only vaccines currently authorized in the U.S. for emergency use, licensed or approved by FDA will be accepted by BOEC.
- Proof of Vaccination must be submitted to the BOEC *before* participation in either single or multi-day programming.
- Please email a copy of your vaccination card to skiconfirmations@boec.org or download a copy of your card to your personal profile on the BOEC database.
- Those who arrive for a lesson or program and have not submitted proof of vaccine will be required to show vaccine card and ID in order to participate.
- **Acceptable Proof of Vaccination includes CDC Covid-19 Vaccination Record Card or acceptable, clear photo of card.**

Exemption from Vaccine Requirement:

- Children under 12 years of age are exempt from vaccine requirement until EAU or approved FDA Covid-19 vaccination is available.
- BOEC will deal with all other exemption requests on a case by case basis.
 - BOEC will refer to the Colorado State's website on reasonable accommodation for medical exemptions.
 - Participant must submit a letter from your primary physician confirming you are not able to be vaccinated due to a medical consideration. Must include the physician's contact information.

COVID 19 Symptoms and Symptom Checks:

- All participants and family members entering a BOEC Ski Program office will be asked to complete a symptom check.
- Before you depart for Summit County, Colorado, affirm you are symptom free.
- While you are in Summit County, if you are sick or have illness symptoms, please stay home.

Other COVID-19 Policies:

- Masks will be required at all times within the Ski Program office regardless of vaccination status.
- Masks will be required outdoors if unable to maintain 6 ft. distance.
- We will be allowing **one** family member or caregiver to accompany participant into the office. Family or caregiver will be required to follow all COVID-19 protocols listed above including proof of vaccination.

BOEC is a highly interactive environment and this update to the current COVID-19 policy is for the benefit of all of our participants, staff and volunteers.

All policies and guidelines are subject to change.
