[Breckenridge, Colo., January 25, 2022] – After a year off due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Banff Centre Mountain Film Festival World Tour and Breckenridge Outdoor Education Center (BOEC) returns with two nights of live action, environmental and adventure films with the [13th Annual Banff Mountain Film Festival](#) at the Riverwalk Center in Breckenridge on Friday and Saturday, February 25 & 26, 2022. Tickets are priced at \$25 for one night or \$40 for a two-night bundle. Doors open at 6pm with films beginning at 7pm. 100% of proceeds benefit BOEC's programs for adaptive recreation and outdoor education.

Traveling to stunning landscapes and remote cultures, and bringing audiences up-close and personal with adrenaline-packed action sports, the 2021/2022 World Tour is an exhilarating and provocative exploration of the mountain world. This was one-day gathering that became the renowned international Festival it is today. Over 30 years ago, Banff Centre Mountain Film Festival began an outreach program to bring the Festival to other communities. This has become known as Banff Centre Mountain Film Festival World Tour. Like the first festival in Banff, the tour began small – three cities across Canada. Banff Centre Mountain Film Festival World Tour now reaches over 40 countries and brings mountain films to an audience of over 550,000 worldwide in approximately 550 locations.
