CamPossible: For Children with Cerebral Palsy

CamPossible is an overnight camp for children with cerebral palsy. The focus of CamPossible is placed on developing positive self-esteem and the confidence to explore new activities and adventures in an accessible environment.

CamPossible promotes motor skills, coordination, balance, problem solving, self-confidence, and lasting friendships among the campers. The staff consists of 2-3 outdoor educators from the Breckenridge Outdoor Education Center and 2-3 occupational therapist or physical therapists from Children's Hospital Colorado. Therapists and staff members will assist with adaptive activities and promote a successful experience for all campers. Campers will assist with the daily routines of meal preparation and clean-up. The days will be filled with opportunities to participate in rock climbing, canoeing, high ropes course, hiking, and fishing, as well as crafts and group games.

Eligible Participants

CamPossible: Designed for children 8-14 years of age with cerebral palsy who are independently mobile with or without the use of adaptive equipment including walkers and crutches.

- Does not have significant cognitive or language limitations
- Must be able to use a toilet with minimal assistance from an adult
- Must be able to follow instructions and comply with adult requests
- Must be able to remain in a group of 13 people without constant one on one attention
- May not have extreme emotional and/or psychological distress

Session Information

Camp will be held in the Griffiths Lodge at the Breckenridge Outdoor Education Center which has indoor plumbing and is fully accessible.
