



ITINERARY

Day One: Parents drop off students at 1:30pm: Ice breaker games and ropes course, sleep in Miners Cabin.

Day Two: Rafting on the Arkansas River, visit Mt. Princeton Hot Springs, camp in Buena Vista.

Day Three: Rock climbing near Buena Vista and camp overnight.

Day Four: Hiking, return to BOEC and sleep in Miners Cabin.

Day Five: Closing ceremony - parents are invited to participate at 1:30pm.

Join the Breckenridge Outdoor Education Center (BOEC) for four nights and five days of adaptive rock climbing, ropes course, and rafting under the sunny skies of Breckenridge, Colorado. Open registration is for boys and girls ages 12-16 who are diagnosed with sensory processing disorders, learning and/or attention

deficits and development delays. BOEC requires that all students be fully independent with self-care tasks, or be prepared to bring a "buddy" to camp. Through outdoor activities such as rock climbing, whitewater rafting, and camping – designed around established experiental education models – students will have the opportunity to develop social skills, teamwork traits and leadership qualities that will transfer into everyday life.



This is a mobile course that begins at BOEC's program site in Breckenridge, Colorado. Students will be involved in cooking, cleaning and gear preparation



during the course; however, the emphasis will be on having fun in a structured setting.

All instruction, meals, rustic accommodation, group camping gear, specialty equipment, transportation during the course and 24-hour instruction & supervision by professional BOEC staff members will be provided. Participant will need to provide their own transportation to Colorado.

REGISTRATION

Registration is currently open and applications will be accepted up until one month prior to course start. Applicants will be screened for appropriateness by BOEC upon receipt of a completed application packet and deposit. Space is limited to 10 participants.
