

Wilderness Camp — June 24-28, 2024



ITINERARY

Day One: Arrival at 10am at BOEC Wilderness Site in Breckenridge, Colorado. Pack personal gear, and drive to Highline State Park to camp.

Day Two: Put-in on the river in Loma, Colorado and river camp that evening.

Day Three: Canoeing on the river and river camping.

Day Four: Canoeing on the river and taking out. Camping and showers at Highline State Park.

Day Five: Return to Breckenridge.

Join the Breckenridge Outdoor Education Center (BOEC) for a four night and five day wilderness trip for young adults (ages 16-21) with developmental and learning disabilities. Though outdoor activities are designed around established experiential education models, students have the opportunity to develop social skills, teamwork and leadership qualities. This adventure-based program allows students to be involved in cooking,



cleaning and gear preparation during the course, with an emphasis on having fun in a structured setting. Activities include canoeing, hiking and river camping.

Instruction, meals, rustic accommodation, group camping gear, specialty equipment, transportation during the course and 24-hour instruction and supervision by professional BOEC staff members will be provided. Participants will need to provide their own transportation to Colorado.



BOEC is a national leader in outdoor adventure education serving all abilities, while ensuring that outdoor adventure recreation is accessible to those with disabilities and special needs. The mission of BOEC is to expand the potential of people with disabilities and special needs through meaningful, educational and inspiring outdoor experiences.
