

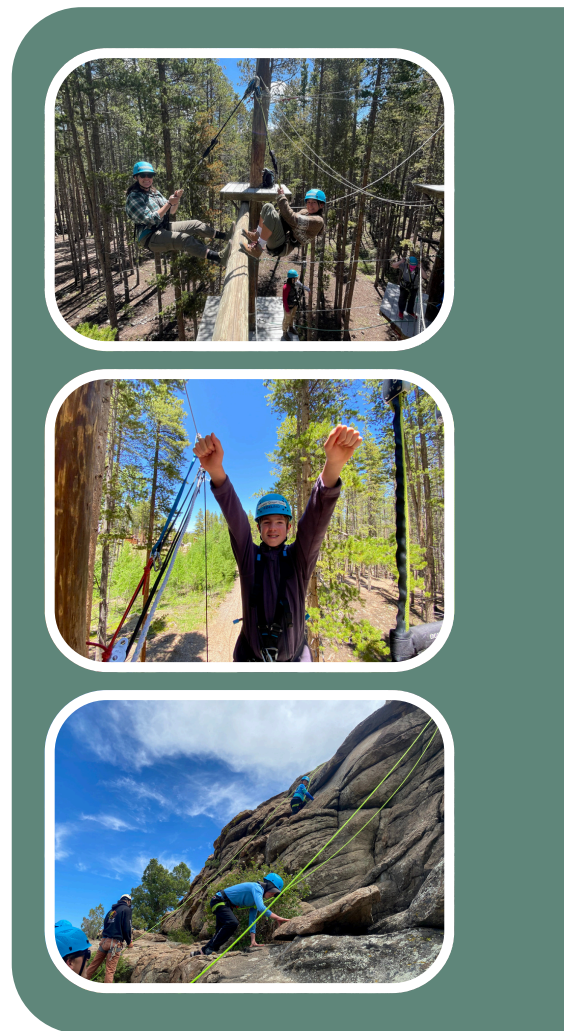


CAMP BIG TREE 2026

SCHEDULE

DAY ONE: Ice breaker games and orientation, sleep in Miners Cabin.

DAY TWO: Onsite high ropes course and sleep in Miners Cabin.

DAY THREE: Rock climbing near Buena Vista and camp overnight.

DAY FOUR: Rafting on the Arkansas River, sleep in Miners Cabin.

DAY FIVE: Closing ceremony - parents are invited to participate.

BOEC requires that all participants be fully independent with self-care tasks, or be prepared to bring a "buddy" to camp.

All instruction, meals, rustic accommodation, group camping gear, specialty equipment, transportation during the course and 24-hour instruction & supervision by professional BOEC staff will be provided. Participant will need to provide their own transportation to Colorado. Transportation to/from Denver may be available for an additional cost.

Registration is currently open and applications will be accepted up until one month prior to course start. Applicants will be screened for appropriateness by BOEC upon receipt of a completed application.
