SCHEDULE

DAY ONE: Arrival at 10am at BOEC Wilderness Site in Breckenridge, CO. Pack personal gear, and drive to James M Robb State Park to camp.

DAY TWO: Put-in on the river in Loma, Colorado and river camp that evening.

DAY THREE: Paddling on the river and river camping.

DAY FOUR: Paddling on the river to the take-out point. Camping at James M Robb State Park.

DAY FIVE: Return to Breckenridge.

*Event activities and dates are subject to change.

Instruction, meals, rustic accommodation, group camping gear, specialty equipment, transportation during the course and 24-hour instruction and supervision by professional BOEC staff members will be provided.

Participants will need to provide their own transportation to Colorado. Transportation to/from Denver may be available for an additional cost.

Registration is currently open and applications will be accepted up until one month prior to course start. Applicants will be screened for appropriateness by BOEC upon receipt of a completed application.
